

THE CHURCH THAT PRAYS PREVAILS THE BELIEVER'S CLUB SERIES- PART 5

SCRIPT: Acts 2:42 (NKJV)- **They continued steadfastly... in prayers.**

The early church was not built on talent or programs, but on **persevering prayer**. Prayer was not a side activity; it was the engine that powered everything they did. If we want to experience the kind of life, power, and revival they walked in, we must return to the same foundation.

Prayer doesn't just ask God for harvest; it **prepares the soil** for it.

This truth is not only biblical; it is the story of **Victory Outreach**. In 1967, God answered the prayers of faithful men and women who refused to believe that addiction, bondage, and brokenness were permanent.

What began in prayer in a small storefront became a global movement touching lives, families, cities, and nations. The method may evolve, but the foundation has never changed, **prayer is still the backbone**.

Revival is not accidental. Revival is agricultural.

Prayer is the seed. Perseverance is the condition. Revival is the harvest.

1. What Is Revival?

Revival is more than an emotional service, it is **transformation**.

It is God breathing life into dead places: Addicts set free, Marriages restored, Prodigals returning, Spiritual hunger reignited.

Revival begins in the **prayer room** before it is ever seen on the platform.

2. Prayer Is the Seed of Revival

Nothing grows without seed, and **prayer is seed**.

Every prayer prayed is seed, every tear shed is seed, every intercession for families, cities, and nations is seed.

We don't pray once and quit, we pray **until something breaks**.

3. Prevailing & Travailing Prayer

This is not a season for casual prayer. **Prevailing prayer** refuses to quit.

It pushes past weariness, delay, and discouragement.

Travailing prayer costs something. It carries the burden for the lost and partners with God until something is birthed.

Victory Outreach was birthed through travailing and prevailing prayer. That same spirit of prayer is rising again.

4. Digging the Wells of Revival

We can't water the fields if the wells are dry.

Like Isaac reopening the wells of Abraham, we are called to **dig again**:

- Wells of prayer
- Wells of fasting
- Wells of repentance
- Wells of hunger for God

The water is already there; it just needs to be uncovered.

If we dig the wells, **God will send the water**. And when the wells are full, the fields will flourish. God is raising up **intercessors** in this hour, men and women who will stand in the gap for their families, their cities, and the next generation.

If the church learns to pray like this, **we will not be the same a year from now**.

The field of revival is ready.

The seed is prayer.

Let's dig the wells and believe God for the harvest.
