

## **New Beginnings- “A New Season of Renewal & Faith”**

Anniversaries are not just for reflection — they are for renewal. This is the beginning of a new chapter. A chapter of greater faith, deeper discipleship, and broader impact. The same God who started this good work is not finished — God is just getting started. This is our season to rise higher, give greater, and walk boldly into the next level of God's calling. **Because the best is not behind us — the best is yet to come!**

God is calling us to let go of the old and step boldly into the new season He is creating. New Beginning isn't just a change of circumstances — it's a divine invitation to start fresh with God. Each new day is a gift, filled with opportunity. Yesterday might have been filled with tears, trials, or even triumphs—but today, God is declaring, **“Behold, I make all things new.”**

God specializes in new beginnings. God turns endings into entrances. He takes what was broken and makes it brand new. When God says “new,” He means renewed purpose, restored joy, and revived faith. **This is our moment to believe again, dream again, and walk boldly into what God is preparing for you.**

In **Isaiah 43:18–19**, God tells His people, **“Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past. Behold, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs forth; do you not perceive it? I will even make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert.”**

### **A New Beginning is an opportunity for...**

#### **1. A New Day — God resets season (PERSONALLY)**

##### **Lamentations 3:22–23**

- Every new day is a divine reset. It's a fresh start, a new chapter in the story God is writing.

#### **2. A New Thing — God's Fresh Move**

##### **Isaiah 43:19**

- God has more in store. He's not recycling your past; He's releasing something brand new.

#### **3. New Perspective — God's Fresh Vision**

##### **Romans 12:2**

- You can't walk into a new season with an old mindset. A new perspective opens your eyes to divine possibilities & opportunities.

#### **4. New Territory — God's Fresh Assignment**

##### **Joshua 1:3**

- Don't settle where you've been—step into what God is showing you. This is your moment to move. Your next level is waiting for your obedience.

**Hebrews 11:1 — “Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.”**

We stand at the threshold of new beginnings — new seasons, new assignments, new opportunities. But to walk in what God is doing next, we must walk by faith.

But as with every new move of God, the **Question is not whether God will do His part —the question is, will we do our part and have the faith to walk in it?**

**There are three dimensions of faith we need to walk in this new beginning:**

**I. FAITH TO FULFILL THE VISION**

**Habakkuk 2:2**

- Every vision from God starts with a word and requires faith to bring it to life. The vision may tarry, but faith keeps us moving forward even when we can't see results yet.
- God gives the picture; faith provides the motion.
- God gives vision, but faith gives it legs — faith walks the vision out day by day.
- You can't fulfill God's vision without faith, because the vision will always be bigger than you.

**EXAMPLES:** Think about Noah. God gave him a vision to build an ark when it had never rained before. We also have the example of our founder Pastor Sonny Argunizoni Sr. to start a ministry for the outcasts of society from scratch.

- Whatever vision God has given you — for ministry, family, business, or your community — don't give up because of delay. Delay is not denial.

**II. FAITH TO WALK IN OUR PERSONAL CALLING**

**Hebrews 11:8**

- Every believer has a personal calling — a divine assignment designed by God.
- Often, God calls us to step out before we see the full picture. Faith says, "Yes, Lord," even when we don't have all the details.
- When we obey in faith, God reveals the next step as we walk.
- Your calling may stretch you, challenge you, and separate you — but faith will sustain you.

**EXAMPLE:** Abraham didn't have a map; he had a word and that word was enough.

- You'll never see the next step until you move on the last instruction.
- Maybe your calling feels too big, too risky, or too costly.
- Obedience is connected to someone else's breakthrough.

In this new beginning, faith will require you to leave your comfort zone. It might mean starting something new, serving, stepping out, forgiving someone who hurt you, or trusting God in your weakness.

**Lastly for the New Beginning we need,**

**III. FAITH TO BE GENEROUS  
2 Corinthians 9:6–8**

- Generosity is one of the purest expressions of faith. When you give, you're saying, "Lord, I trust that You are my source."
- Faith-filled generosity doesn't give out of surplus — it gives out of trust.
- It's not about how much you have; it's about how much you believe.
- God often tests our generosity before He releases our abundance. Because giving is never about money; it's about faith and obedience.

**EXAMPLE:** In 1 Kings 17, the widow of Zarephath had just enough flour and oil for one last meal. But when the prophet Elijah asked her to make a small cake first, she obeyed in faith. And the Bible says her jar never ran out! Faith to give opened the door for her miracle.

- If you want to see God do new things, you must release what's in your hand. When you give in faith, you invite Heaven to multiply your seed.
- New beginnings require open hands — we can't receive the new if we're holding on to the old.

**CONCLUSION:**

This is a season of new beginnings. But new beginnings are not automatic — they are *activated* by faith. Faith to see the vision fulfilled. Faith to walk in your divine calling. Faith to be generous, even when it costs you something.

- **Faith is how we partner with God's purpose.**
- **Faith is how we move from promise to possession.**
- **Faith is how we walk into the "new thing" God is doing.**

*Philippians 1:6 declares, "He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion."*

**So, as you step into this new season, hold your head high and your heart steady. God has already gone before you. The same God who started this journey with you will finish it through you.**

**CLOSING PRAYER:** Father, thank you for this season of new beginnings. Today, we choose to walk by faith and not by sight. Give us faith to fulfill every vision You've spoken, faith to walk boldly in our calling, and faith to be generous in every area of our lives. Let Your Spirit strengthen us for the journey ahead, for You are faithful to complete what You have started. Amen.
